SUMMER TASKS – BTEC Uniformed Protective Services

Subject: UPS (Level 2 & 3)

Title: "My aspirations in the Uniformed Protective Services".

Task: The Uniformed Protective Services (UPS) are often described as 'a society within society' (James 2016). This recognises that, although members of the UPS are drawn from all different walks of life, their service sets them apart in both the powers they are given and the responsibilities and values and standards they must uphold.

As part of studying towards the qualification in UPS, you will at times be asked to consider your own future aspirations and how the course theory fits within the context of your chosen UPS.
