## 1. Writing

Please write at least 200 words **in German** covering the following areas:



- You and your family (using the present tense)
- Hobbies or free time activities, including something you have done or somewhere you have been recently (using the past tense)
- What you would like to do next year at York College, and later in life (using the future tense)

Try to include as wide a variety of vocabulary and sentence structures as possible.

## 2. Research

Choose and research one of the following areas. Write at least 300 words **in English** about what you have found out using your own words, without copying and pasting from a website. You can include pictures, maps etc.

- One or more aspects of life in Berlin–sights, museums, music, history...
- Art / an artist in the German-speaking world
- Architecture / an architect / a building in the German-speaking world
- Music / a musician / band from the German-speaking world
- TV / a TV programme or series in the German-speaking world
- A German / Austrian / Swiss festival or tradition
- At least one German-speaking YouTuber

We will be looking at all these areas during the AS course next year, so you will have a head start!
