Contra-Indications to Treatment

The range of treatments available in the salon may not be suitable for every individual. If you are taking medication, or have certain medical conditions, some treatment may be inadvisable, restricted or require a doctors or health professional consent note in advance.

Individual suitability for treatment will be assessed personally by the session tutor and will be at their discretion.

Contra-Indications Include:

- Contagious infections/diseases/infestations
- Viral/fungal/bacterial infections
- Broken bones/recent scar tissue/fractures/sprains
- Cuts/abrasions/undiagnosed lumps and swellings
- High/low blood pressure/circulatory conditions
- During chemotherapy/radiotherapy
- Recent operations (in the last 12 months)
- Varicose veins/deep vein thrombosis/phlebitis
- Hyper-keratosis/severe nail separation
- Sever skin conditions/eczema/psoriasis
- Heart problems
- Diabetes
- Hormone imbalances
- Systemic diseases
- Epilepsy
- Thyroid conditions
- Allergies/skin disorders
- Asthma
- HIV/AIDS
- ME
- MS
- Eye infections

Covid 19

Covid 19 symptoms include:

- **A high temperature**
this means feeling hot to touch on your chest or back.
- **A new continuous cough**
this means coughing a lot for more than an hour or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough it may be worse).

Skin Testing Information for Hair & Beauty Treatments

As a duty of care to our clients, a skin test is required prior to a colour application, for both hair and beauty. This only takes a couple of minutes, please ask at reception for details.

Hairdressing Skin Testing: required a minimum of 48 hours and a maximum of 7 days before a hair colour application.

Beauty Skin Testing: required a minimum of 24 hours and a maximum of 48 hours before eyelash and eyebrow tinting.

If you have a reaction to any of the skin tests you must notify the salon straight away. If it becomes very uncomfortable you must seek medical advice. A reaction can be identified by redness, the skin can become swollen, itchy and you could get a headache. If you experience any of these things, you must not have the colour applied directly to your scalp.

This is the only precautionary test that we do as a College to safeguard our clients and although this test has been carried out, there is no guarantee that a reaction may not occur as a result of colouring. No under 16's can have any colour application.

Provision of some services and treatments will be at the tutor's discretion.

To ensure fair access to assessment opportunities, and equal opportunities for all students, and a diverse range of clients, it is not possible for clients to request a specific student to work on them.

All clients need to report to the Hair & Beauty Reception prior to treatments commencing in compliance with health and safety guidelines.



We politely request that you observe the following salon guidelines:

- In the event of a fire all clients are required to follow College evacuation procedure.
- For the comfort and relaxation of yourself and other clients please switch off mobile phones or put them on silent.
- Food is not permitted in any of the salons or treatment rooms.
- Please enter treatment rooms quietly in respect of other clients who may be enjoying a relaxing and peaceful treatment.
- Treatments may be restricted if effected by contra-indications. Please see page 2.
- Children under the age of 5 years of age are not permitted in any of our Training Salons due to health and safety.
- Anyone under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times whilst at the salon.
- Persons under 18 are only allowed in the salons if attending for a permitted treatment, and have written consent from a parent or legal guardian.
- The College are not responsible for any loss or damage of personal belongings.

A course of four treatments is recommended (the 4th treatment being free of charge).

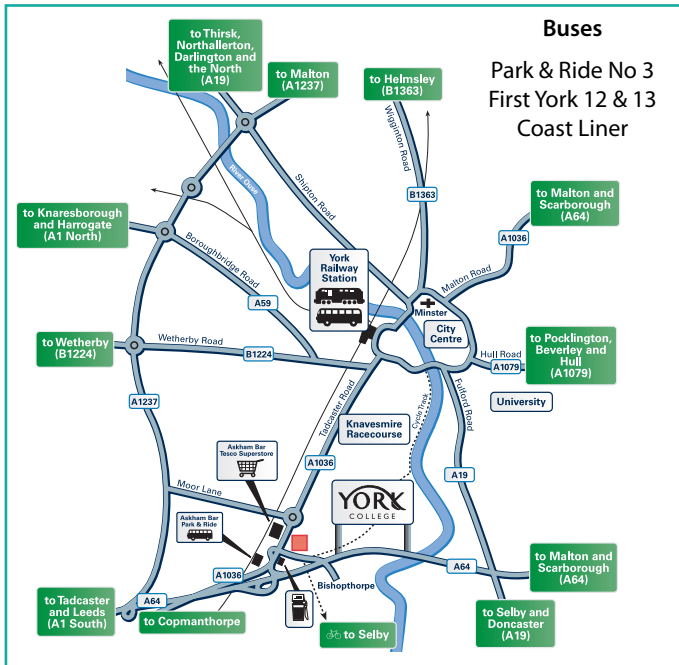
