### OVERVIEW

#### PROS

Use of natural and locally sourced native wood and veneers

#### CONS

Plated metal process and solvent-based adhesives

### KEY PROCESSES

- General assembly by hand
- CNC milling of wood
- CNC milling of metal
- Laser cutting

### CORE MATERIALS

- Laminated ply
- Solid Walnut sides

### ADHESIVE

- Veneer: Solvent-based
- Leather: Solvent-based
- Assembly: Solvent-based

### CLADDING

- Natural veneers
- Tooling hide leather
- Polished metal

### FINISH

- Oil
- Lacquer (water based?)
- Wax
- Gold plating

### POTENTIAL ALTERNATIVES

- Flax composite
- Veneer: Water-based
- Leather: Water-based
- Assembly: Water-based
- Replace trim with solid wood

- Could be improved
