


Sulis Hospital has four state-of-the-art theatres capable of supporting complex surgery.



A combination of new surgical techniques and advances in anaesthesia is leading to a shift to same-day surgery for joint replacements to include robotic-assisted hip and knee replacements.

This gives greater flexibility in the patient's journey to minimise stress and anxiety and facilitate a faster recovery. Patients will be back home the same day and are usually able to get back to their daily life quicker.

The theatres are equipped with the latest technologies across all surgical specialities and a modern purpose-designed endoscopy suite enables Sulis Hospital to be a leading provider of endoscopy services with JAG accreditation.

ENT, Audiology and Hearing Therapy

The Bath ENT Consultants are partners in the practice and work together as a team. This enables them to cover all ENT conditions with their own sub-specialities. The Practice Manager will direct referrals to the most appropriate specialist. Bath ENT also now provide a full audiology assessment service at Sulis Hospital, for self-pay, insured, and NHS patients. The introduction of new audiology equipment and a brand-new soundproof booth, mean that a high-quality gold standard hearing assessment can be performed throughout the daytime and during evening appointments. This assessment includes a full suite of air and bone conduction audiometry with masking and tympanometry, alongside individual explanation of results by consultants and impartial advice on hearing aids where needed. This service is open not only to patients referred into the ENT team, both private and NHS, but also as a standalone rapid access audiology service for private patients. Unlike many high-street screening and hearing aid retailers, this new service links audiology and ENT Consultants together, provides a gold standard assessment, and allows patients access to combined speciality secondary care where needed, for a range of conditions including unilateral or bilateral hearing loss, tinnitus, glue ear, and eustachian tube dysfunction, cholesteatoma and much more.

All the ENT consultants carry out the following procedures, Grommets, Tonsillectomy, Septoplasty, Suction clearance, FESS, Nasal and Ear polyps, Adenoid removal, Deviated septum, Ear infection, Glue ear, Runny nose, Laryngitis, Excision of external lesion, Ear discharge.
