- 2. I will pay the Academy Squad contribution towards the cost of coaching of £70.
- 3. I will sign and return the Squash Wales Code of Conduct and Commitment Statement and the Squash Wales Code of Conduct for Away Events.
- 4. In order to be eligible for Welsh representation, all players will be judged on attendance, commitment, behaviour, attitude and results in the following:
- 5. National Squads that the player has been invited to.
- 6. Welsh National Events-Welsh Jnr Open, North Wales Jnr Open, Welsh Jnr Closed.
- 7. Welsh Regional tournaments.
- 8. Welsh League results.
- 9. Regional Academy Day squads and weekly Academy training night squads.
- 10. English Inter-County Championships (if selected)
- 11. English Silver tournaments
- 12. British Closed and Open and European Tournaments.

NOTE: "THAT YOUR COMMITMENT LEVEL WILL FORM PART OF SELECTION — NOTE: POOR COMMITMENT MAY LEAD TO NON-SELECTION"

1. If I am not able to attend a Squad I will complete an Exception Request Form and forward it to my Squad Coach or the Squash Wales office at least 1 week prior to the date.

Please note that your compliance with the criteria listed in points 1 to 6 above will be monitored and your failure to comply with these criteria and conditions, and those contained in the Code of Conduct & Commitment, may result in your removal from the relevant squad and the Academy Programme. If you are excluded you will be notified by the Director of Coaching & Development with an explanation outlining the reasoning.

You will only be able to miss a Squad if you are injured or ill and you must ring your Squad Coach or the Squash Wales office to confirm why you will not be able to attend. You must also supply a Medical Certificate within 1 week of the date of the Squad.

Players are personally responsible for entering and paying the entry fees prior to all tournaments in order to meet the relevant condition in point 3 above.

If a player withdraws two days before the first scheduled match or during the event they will receive zero ranking points unless:

- I. They notify the Tournament Director that they are unable to play, **AND**
- II. provide written proof of sickness or injury within 1 week of the last day of the tournament.

If a player withdraws from any tournament, including a European event, for any reason, they will be liable for any costs e.g. packages, entry fees, t-shirts, etc. incurred by Squash Wales arising out of their withdrawal.
