

The Venues

SPORT WALES NATIONAL CENTRE (SWNC), SOPHIA GARDENS, CARDIFF – THE HOME OF SQUASH WALES

This is one of the two National Sports Centres in Wales used for the development of elite athletes. The facilities include 4 squash courts including 2 glass back courts, 10 badminton courts, all-weather tennis courts, and a floodlit artificial pitch.

CARDIFF SQUASH RACKETS CLUB, RYDER STREET, CARDIFF

This is a private members club that has four courts including 1 glass back court, a bar and a gym.

Both venues are within walking distance of the City Centre, Cardiff Castle, the Millennium Stadium and Leonardo Hotel. (We recommend that you park your car at SWNC and walk to the hotels as car parking charges near the hotels can be expensive).

The tournament hotel is the Leonardo Hotel (formerly Jurys Inn), 1 Park Place, Cardiff, CF10 3UD.

Meal Information

FRIDAY

Dinner is provided on Friday at Cardiff SRC from 8.30pm onwards for all players and guests on the food package.

SATURDAY

Lunch is provided on Saturday at Cardiff SRC between 12.30pm and 2.30pm for all players and guests on the food package.

The presentation dinner will be held at the Leonardo Hotel (tournament hotel) on the Saturday evening. Drinks at 7.00pm to sit down at 8.00pm. Dress will be smart/casual.

Leonardo Hotel operates a cashless policy so you will need credit/debit card to purchase drinks etc...

SCORING

Definitions

- All events will be PAR 11. At 10 all win by 2 clear points.
- A tie is a series of five matches played between two countries.
- A match is played between individual players.

Allocation of points

1 point shall be awarded for each game won in a match.

5 bonus points are awarded to the team winning the tie. The winner of a match between two countries is the team with the most points.

In the case of the number of points being equal, the winner will be the team with the highest number of match wins. To decide team positions the results will be taken in the following order:

- a. highest number of match wins
- b. highest number of points for
- c. lowest number of points against
- d. the result of the match between the two teams who are tied

Order of play

The order of play on each court shall be 5 - 3 - 1 - 4 - 2

Practice courts

Available on request from 2 o'clock Friday at the Sport Wales National Centre.

Referee

Referees will be provided for every match. Although there might well be an occasion where teams may be expected to referee matches. Team captains will be responsible for the allocating of referees if required.

Captains Meeting

There will be a brief captains meeting at 16.30 in the bar area. Each team will be provided with a squad seeding's form and match playing order forms beforehand. The squad seeding's form and the playing order form for the first match needs to be provided at this meeting.

Subsequent playing order forms need to be provided 15 minutes before the start of a match.
