- Ratify MHI teams
- Promote success at MHI
- Identify and discuss events that form the calendar of Masters squash
- Contribute to events in the calendar
- Support and promote Masters squash in Wales
- Feedback Masters concerns and ideas to the squash community in Wales
- Set targets for Masters squash in Wales
- Provide updates on Masters events to Squash Wales for website or newsletter inclusion
- Take part in other volunteer roles that arise to promote squash
