If the Winter-half winner does not wish to host, the team that wins the Spring half (January to April) will then have the opportunity to host, subject to the conditions below. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The host team has space to accommodate at least 60 spectators. 2. The host team provides refreshments at a reasonable cost, as agreed by Squash Wales. 3.
