



Squash Wales Membership Terms and Conditions

By registering for membership with Squash Wales, you agree to the following terms and conditions.

1. Membership

Membership is open to individuals who meet the eligibility criteria determined by Squash Wales.

Membership is subject to acceptance by Squash Wales and may be suspended or withdrawn where these terms are breached.

2. Personal Information

By becoming a member, you consent to Squash Wales collecting and processing your personal information in accordance with its Privacy Notice and UK data protection legislation.

Your information will be used to:

- administer your membership
- organise competitions and events
- communicate important membership information
- fulfil safeguarding and governance obligations
- produce anonymised participation statistics where appropriate.

3. Code of Conduct

Members agree to:

- treat others with dignity and respect
- comply with the Squash Wales Code of Conduct
- follow safeguarding and equality policies
- avoid abusive, discriminatory or unacceptable behaviour
- uphold the reputation of squash in Wales.

Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action.

4. Safeguarding

All members are expected to support a safe and inclusive environment for children and adults at risk and comply with Squash Wales safeguarding policies.

Any safeguarding concerns should be reported using the procedures published by Squash Wales.

5. Competitions

Members entering competitions agree to abide by:

- Squash Wales regulations
- applicable competition rules
- decisions of referees and tournament officials.

6. Membership Fees

Membership fees are non-refundable except where required by law or at the discretion of Squash Wales.

Membership begins once payment has been successfully processed.

7. Communications

Squash Wales will send members essential communications relating to membership, competitions, governance and safeguarding.

Marketing communications will only be sent where consent has been given, and members may withdraw this consent at any time.

8. Photography and Media

Photographs and video may be taken at events for promotional and reporting purposes.

Where required, consent will be obtained in accordance with safeguarding and data protection requirements.

9. Changes to Terms

Squash Wales reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions. Members will be notified of significant changes.
