## LARGE DIAMONDS BLANKET

## ABBREVIATIONS

K = Knit
P = Purl
Rep $=$ repeat
Sts = Stitch[es]

## INSTRUCTIONS

With 200g DK yarn and 4mm needle (size 8) cast on 129 sts then K15 rows.
At beg and end of each row K8 sts for border.
18 row Pattern for middle 113 sts.
Row 1: K8, (P1, K15) repeat 5 times, P1, K8
Row 2: P7, (K3, P13) repeat 5 times, K3, P7
Row 3: K6, (P5, K11) repeat 5 times, P5, K6
Row 4: P5, (K7, P9) repeat 5 times, K7, P5
Row 5: K4, (P9, K7) repeat 5 times, P9, K4
Row 6: P3, (K11, P5) repeat 5 times, K11, P3
Row 7: K2, (P13, K3) repeat 5 times, P13, K2
Row 8: P1, (K15, P1) repeat 5 times, K15, P1
Row 9: border - P - border

Rows 10 to 17: As rows 8 to 1 working backwards.
Row 18: As row 9.
Rep pattern until work measures approx. $28^{\prime \prime}$.
K15 rows. Cast off.

## SMALL DIAMONDS BLANKET

## INSTRUCTIONS

With 200g DK yarn and 4mm needles (size 8) cast on 129 sts then K17 rows
At beg and end of each row K9 sts for border.
12 row Pattern for middle 111 sts.
Row 1: (P1, k9) rep to last st, P1
Row 2: K2, (P7, K3) rep to last 9 sts, P7, K2
Row 3: P3, (K5, P5) rep to last 8 sts, K5, P3
Row 4: K4, (P3, K7) rep to last 7 sts, P3, K4
Row 5: P5, (K1, P9) rep to last 6 sts, K1, P5
Row 6: K
Row 7: As row 5
Row 8: As row 4
Row 9: As row 3
Row 10: As row 2
Row 11: As row 1
Row 12: P
Rep pattern until work measures approximately 27 inches.
K 17 rows. Cast off.

These two blankets are reversible and should measure approx. $75 \times 60 \mathrm{~cm}$ ( $30 \times 24$ inches)
