

No-sew Squares Blanket

ABBREVIATIONS

K = Knit

P = Purl

Rep = repeat

Sts = Stitch[es]

Tog = Together

Pssso = Pass slipped stitch over

INSTRUCTIONS

With using 200g DK yarn and 3.75mm (size 9) needles cast on 33 sts.

K one row.

Next row: K15, slip 1, K2 tog, pssso, k15.

K one row

Next row right side facing: K14, slip 1, K2 tog, pssso, K14.

K one row.

Continue in this way until 1 stitch remains then fasten off.

This first square will be on the bottom left-hand corner of the finished blanket.

To make the next square, cast on 17 sts and with right side facing and the cast-on sts on the right-hand needle, pick up 16 sts along the right-hand side of the first square.

Work the second square on these sts. Make as many squares as you want on the bottom line, remembering that maximum blanket size must be no more than 24" wide.

To make the left-hand square on the next line, pick up 16 sts along the top of the first square then cast on 17 sts. Work the square on these sts.

For the next and all subsequent squares on that line, pick up 16 sts on the top of the square below, one stitch right in the corner and 16 sts up the right-hand side of the previous square.

Make as many lines as you need remembering that maximum size should be 24" x 24" or 24" x 30".

Weave in as many ends as you can while working. Fasten off remaining ends.
