



WIDE STRIPED BLANKET

ABBREVIATIONS

K = Knit

P = Purl

Rep = repeat

Sts = Stitch[es]

HINTS AND TIPS

Striped blankets are knitted from bottom to top and can be stripes of different colours or different stitches or both. The stripes can be evenly spaced or as the fancy takes you.

The blankets can be made square 60 x 60 cm (24 x 24 inches) or rectangular 75 x 60 cm (30 x 24 inches).

INSTRUCTIONS

With using 200g DK Yarn and 4mm (size 8) needles, cast on 129 sts.

Start with a garter stitch border: K15 rows.

Row 1: K

Row 2: K8, P to last 8 sts, K8

Repeat rows 1 and 2, 9 times

Row 21: K8, (P1, K1) rep to last 8 sts, K8

Rep row 21, 19 times.

Rep rows 1-40, 3 times, then rows 1-20 once.

This makes 9 stripes, and your blanket should measure around 23"

K15 rows for top border; cast off.

Knitting 2 more stripes will make the blanket 30" long.
