Individual grants

Awarded to young people eligible for financial support towards CCF costs (such as boots or activity fees). These grants are initiated by a volunteer in the CCF Contingent

Recognition

Our Praiseworthy Action Certificates are awarded to young people who are enrolled in the CCF as a cadet and have done something worthy of praise. For example, doing real first aid, raising money for a charity, supporting the community.

Legal support line

Accessible to adult volunteers in the event of any incidents or issues arising during CCF activities. Support includes arrest assistance, along with representation at a criminal trial or coroner's inquest.

Care First

24 hour confidential advice and support for adult volunteers, including up to six sessions of free counselling.

President's Certificate

Awarded to adult volunteers in recognition of long or special service in the CCF or to recognise an unusual contribution.

Marketing support for volunteer recruitment

Contingent Support Officers are embedded in your local Cadet Training Teams. Our CSOs are on hand to support the efficiency and sustainability of your contingent.



Support your charity

Group Activity Grant

This is up to £750.

Contingents can apply to CCFA for funding to reduce the cost of a trip for all participating cadets.

Insurances for CCF Contingents

For a small per-person fee, take out Public Liability and Personal Accident Insurance that fulfils the Army's insurance requirements for CCF activity.

For a per-person, per-day charge take out travel insurance when attending any organised and authorised cadet activity overseas. A UK-option is also available should it be required.
