

M42 full weekend closures between J6 to 9 northbound and J7a to 6 southbound

(including the M6 J4a southbound link to M42 in both directions and temporary M6toll restrictions between M6 J3a to T1 northbound and from T2 southbound closures)

Location

M42 between junctions 6 to 9 northbound and 7a to 6 southbound

(including M6 J4a southbound link to M42 in both directions).

M6 northbound J3a link to M6toll T1 and M6 Toll southbound from T2.

Duration

From 9pm on Friday 24 July until 5am Monday 27 July 2026.

M6toll southbound at T2 from 10pm Friday 24 July until 12pm (midday) Saturday 25 July 2026.

What we are doing

Traffic management will be in place to enable our workforce to safely continue installing beams for the M42 Motorway Box in Solihull and to progress deck installation works on the Water Orton Viaducts across the motorway in North Warwickshire.

What to expect

A fully signed diversion route will be in place throughout the full weekend closures.

Low level noise from our works site.

These works are subject to consent.

M42 J6 to 9 northbound and M6 J4a southbound link to M42 northbound/south diversion

During the full weekend closure between M42 J6 to 9 northbound (*including the M6 J4a link to the M42 northbound/southbound*) road users should follow the fully signed diversion route and allow more time for journeys.

M6 toll northbound connecting road closure between M6 J3a to T1: (during the M42 full weekend closures).

From 9pm on Friday 24 July until 5am Monday 27 July 2026, *during the full weekend closures of the M42.*

You will still be able to reach your destination. Please follow the fully signed diversion and allow extra time for your journey.

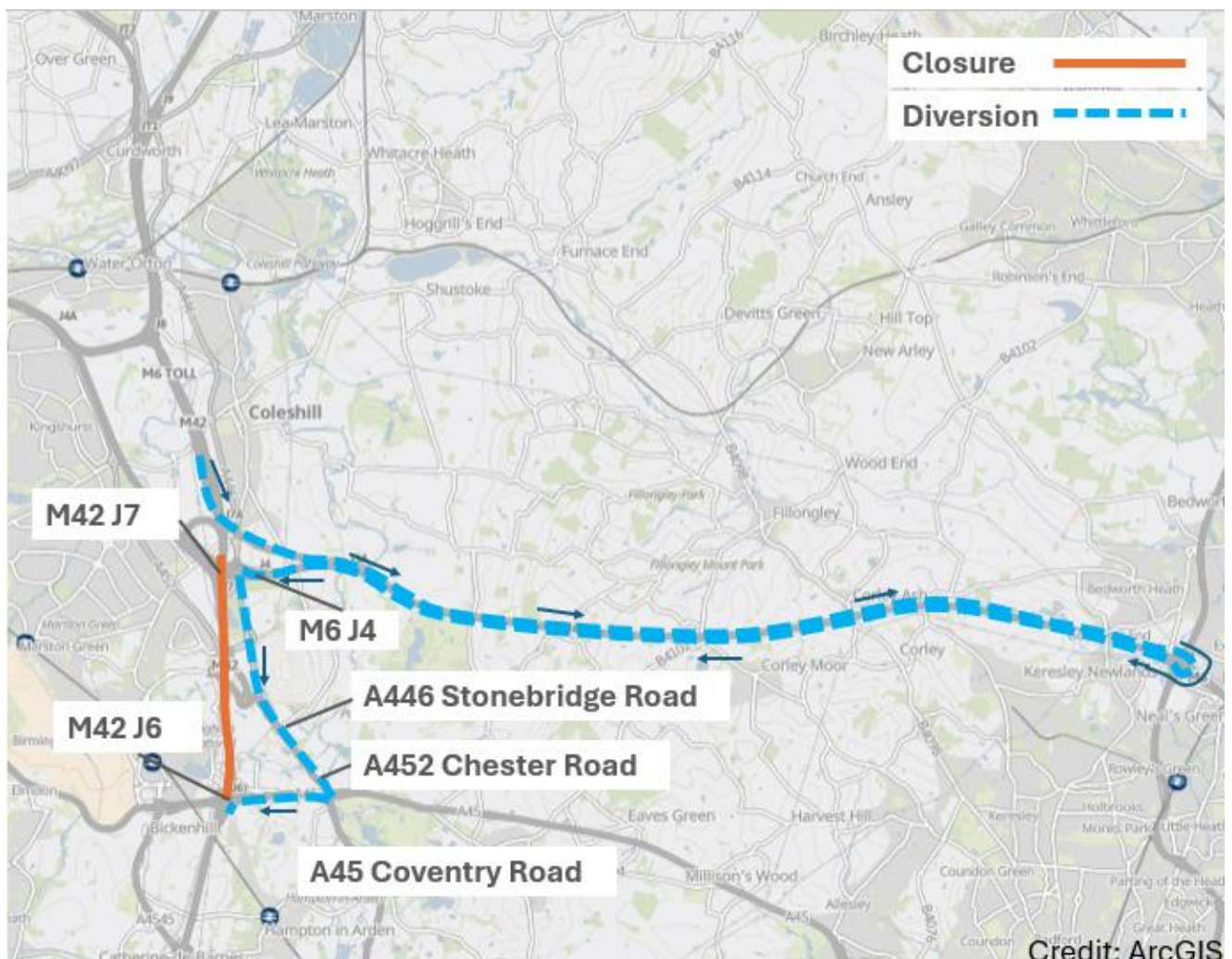


M42 J6 to 7a southbound diversion

During the M42 full weekend closures between J7a to 6 southbound, road users should follow the fully signed diversion route and allow more time for journeys.

M6 toll southbound closure from T2: From 10pm Friday 24 July until 12pm (midday) Saturday 25 July 2026, during the full weekend closures of the M42, a section of the M6 Toll to the M42 southbound carriageway will be temporarily closed for essential works and will reopen once it is safe to do so.

You will still be able to reach your destination. Please follow the fully signed diversion and allow extra time for your journey.



Keeping you informed about major HS2 works on the M42 and M6

Additional temporary weekend closures are planned throughout Summer and Autumn 2026 across Solihull and North Warwickshire. By coordinating our work across multiple HS2 worksites and with National Highways we have reduced the number of closures required.
