Mones says...

The greatest fulfilment in life comes when we know that we are in the perfect will of God. It is only in this place that we can find and enjoy contentment.

However, "how do I find the will of God, enter it and remain in it?" is the question that needs to be persistently asked till a satisfying answer is found, lived in and enjoyed.

An acquaintance of mine once commented that I didn't see myself walking in the will of God at that particular time. Wow! Did that send me on a tizz wizz or what!

When we are not sure about whether we are in the perfect will of God our words, demeanour and actions give the game away, people around us will pick that up. To help us move forward in understanding God's will for our lives we need to discern and understand the difference between the general and specific will of God for us.

The general will of God for us is that we should be saved, grow into discipleship mature in faith, remain in holiness and be faithful in the way we live through our interactions with him and the world.

On the other hand, the specific will of God for us is more to do with the context in which we work out what we need to do to have the reality of the above in our lives. This can be done through seeking Him, focusing on Jesus, keeping Jesus central in our lives, loving His word, engaging in prayer, entering into worship, belonging to a Christian community, and finally surrendering our desires, passions and ambitions to Him.

One of my favourite Hillsong worship songs is "I surrender all" however, I have to confess, it is easier said than done, but contentment is only found in doing so. Go on let God lead in the specific, seek Him, listen to His voice and He will lead you into the place where you will know contentment and joy.

Trust in the Lord and lean not on your understanding and he will direct you in all your ways.
