WHITECHAPEL ESTATE

Tom Stuart-Smith's studio is working with Adjaye Associates and PLP Architecture on the redevelopment of London's Whitechapel Estate for developers Londonewcastle. The new residential and office district will provide more than 7,000 square metres of open space, including a green spine with a high proportion of perennial planting and a mix of deciduous trees. Narrow paved areas will form clear pathways through irregular-shaped planting beds, then open up to create seating or gathering spaces. One side of a new mews-like street will continue the planting pattern while the other side will have space for an open lawn, large beds and specimen trees. tomstuartsmith.co.uk
