

Testing Your Child for COVID-19



If your child has symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) or you would like to have a COVID-19 test for another reason, please call your child's primary care provider. If your provider determines that your child should have a test at Cincinnati Children's, they will put in an order or take a sample in their office and send it to us.

Your options are:

Burnet Campus (3333 Burnet Avenue, Cincinnati OH 45229)

Go to the main entrance, and follow signs for the testing location.

Liberty Campus (7777 Yankee Road, Liberty Township, OH 45044)

Turn right at the stop sign by the ED and follow the road around the Proton Therapy Center to the parking lot that is visible from I-75.

Neighborhood Locations

Look for signs when you arrive, park in a designated space and follow the instructions to let the lab team know you have arrived. Stay in your car, and a team member will be out to help you.

After the test is ordered, we ask that you *wait two to three hours* before calling the Scheduling Center at **513-517-2670** to make your appointment at a Cincinnati Children's testing location.

The Burnet and Liberty locations have the largest capacity for tests each day, and may be the only options available if the others have filled all appointments.

Scheduling Center Hours:
7:30am – 5pm, Mon – Fri.

Note: If your child is being tested prior to a surgical or other medical procedure, the process and testing locations may be different. Please contact the care team that is doing your child's procedure, if you have questions.
