

# CCHMC COVID19 Testing Guidance

## Routine Testing Indications:

### Symptomatic Patients per clinician discretion:

- Fever
- Cough
- Nasal congestion or rhinorrhea
- Sore throat
- Shortness of breath
- Diarrhea
- Nausea or vomiting
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Myalgia
- Poor feeding or poor appetite

### Asymptomatic Patients:

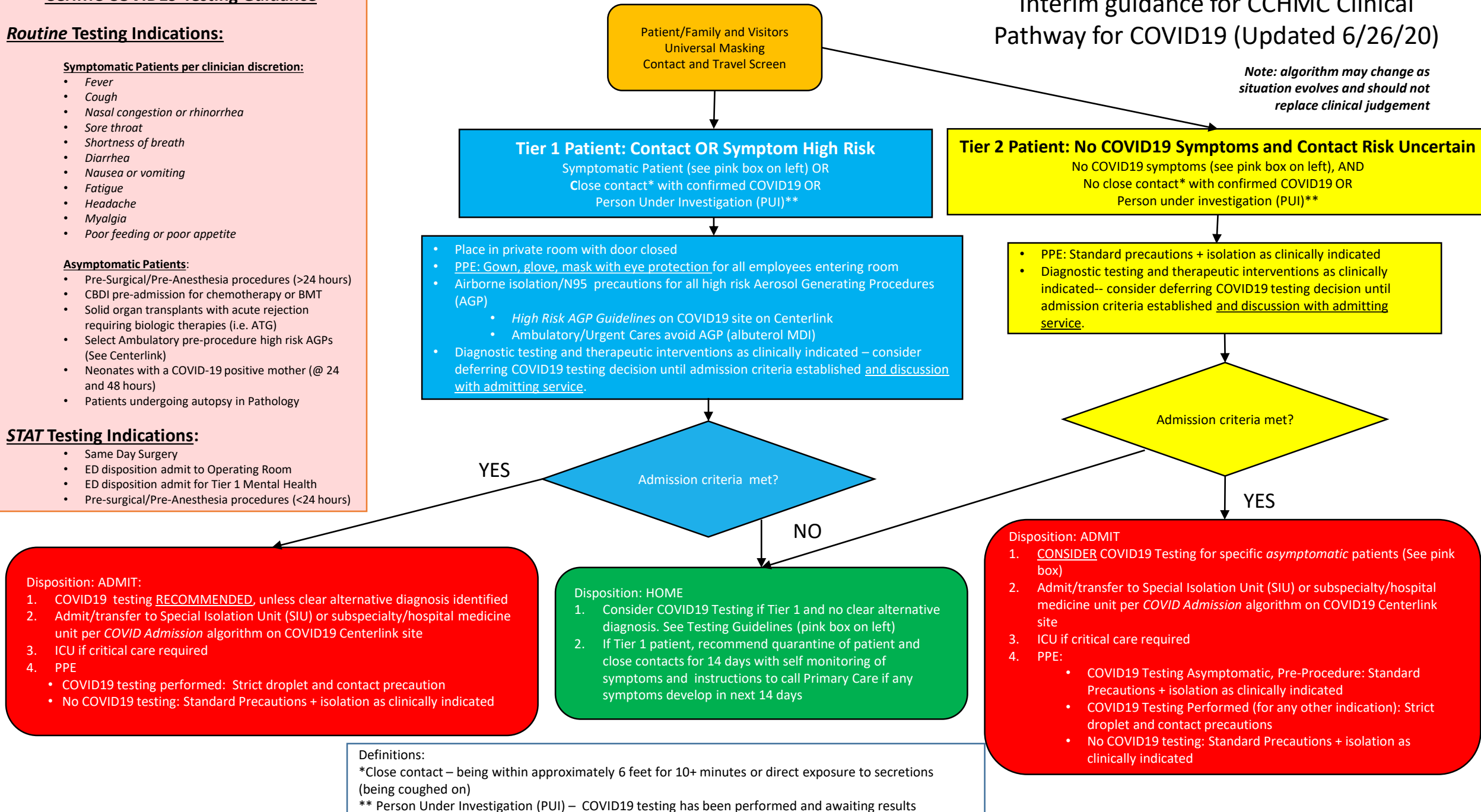
- Pre-Surgical/Pre-Anesthesia procedures (>24 hours)
- CBDI pre-admission for chemotherapy or BMT
- Solid organ transplants with acute rejection requiring biologic therapies (i.e. ATG)
- Select Ambulatory pre-procedure high risk AGPs (See Centerlink)
- Neonates with a COVID-19 positive mother (@ 24 and 48 hours)
- Patients undergoing autopsy in Pathology

## STAT Testing Indications:

- Same Day Surgery
- ED disposition admit to Operating Room
- ED disposition admit for Tier 1 Mental Health
- Pre-surgical/Pre-Anesthesia procedures (<24 hours)

# Interim guidance for CCHMC Clinical Pathway for COVID19 (Updated 6/26/20)

*Note: algorithm may change as situation evolves and should not replace clinical judgement*



**Definitions:**  
 \*Close contact – being within approximately 6 feet for 10+ minutes or direct exposure to secretions (being coughed on)  
 \*\* Person Under Investigation (PUI) – COVID19 testing has been performed and awaiting results
